Here is what I have come up with for the OT proposal for Iroquois Park Overlook

Average officer OT rate is \$65.91 hour 65.91 an hour x 4 hours = \$263.64 per 4 hour block The total estimated cost would be around \$2,109.12 for 8 shifts (4 hours per shift). This number could fluctuate depending on the officer who signs up based on their years of service. If a new officer signs up their OT rate would be a little less than this. If an officer who has many years of service works this, their OT rate would be a little higher. There is no way to know exactly due to the variances of years of service and we don't know at this time which officers would be signing up. Let me know if you have any questions.

Good Afternoon Officer Spaulding and Arroyo,

Our office, D15, Metro Parks Leadership, and Olmsted Parks Conservancy met last week to discuss the schedule for public access to the Iroquois Overlook this year.

The proposed plan is the have the Iroquois Overlook open one weekend per month starting in March and going through October. Parks can close the gate and clear any stragglers out on Sunday evenings. Saturday nights are more challenging

for staff due to schedules and the volume of folks. For these reasons, we are seeking LMPD overtime be funded for this propose.

Overtime Request

OT Iroquois Overlook (4 hours) per month, March – October (8 times in a calendar year) on Saturday night the last weekend of the month. Overlook closes at 6pm. Once the loop is cleared of people/cars and the gate is closed, then OT hours can be spent in nearby areas, depending on funding sources of OT.
