Hi folks,

Given the PSA about the bars on Bardstown Road, and the concerning rise in violence against women/sexual assault nationwide, I'd like to purchase some of the coasters that test for date rape drugs for y'all to distribute to local bars (I'm assuming this is something ABC is best situated to do, although I'm copying Major Allen with LMPD since we discussed this yesterday).

Can I give you all \$1500 or so (I can check my accounts but I probably have a bit more if needed) to make an initial purchase? I think I just need an email from someone in ABC saying that you're willing to accept the funds for me to get started with the paperwork on my side.

It looks like there are a few companies that make these (Guard My Drink and DrinkSafe were the ones that popped up for me), and that they run around \$1-\$2 per coaster. We could give bars bags of like 100, and, when we drop them off, make them sign an acknowledgement that these aren't a replacement for security

efforts and aren't intended to be any sort of dispositive scientific test or to be represented to customers as such. We could also leave some with ABC and LMPD officers so that they could have them on hand if the need arose.
