The public has the right to comment on the proposal at the Public Hearing. The property owner or their representative and other persons in support of overturning the Commission's decision will have 40 minutes to speak. Thereafter, persons in support of upholding the Commission's decision will have 45 minutes to speak. Finally, the property owner or their representative may have 5 minutes for rebuttal.
