

2018 Grants



- **3** Administrative Clerks Changes and Expected Effects
 - Priority 1 runs will be transferred to MetroSafe on weekends and after 4:30pm on weekdays.
 - 1 Animal Control Officer will be taken off the street Monday Friday to handle dispatch from 7:30am – 4:30pm.

- 2 Animal Care Specialists Changes and Expected Effects
 - 2 Animal Control Officers will be taken off the street to back fill the daily duties of the 2 lost positions (cleaning, feeding animals, vaccinating, working intake, etc.).
- **1 Public Education Coordinator** Changes and Expected Effects
 - The job duties of this position will have to be absorbed by the Rescue Coordinator, Foster Coordinator, Behavior Coordinator, and others.
 - Animal Services will have to minimize community events.
