- Criminal Justice Coordinating Council (CJCC)
- Established in 1967 Oldest CJCC in continuous operation nationally (NACo)
- LMCJC was established by local Ordinance
- Neutral forum to bring stakeholders to the table to discuss criminal justice policy
- Encourages the development of effective, cost efficient and evidenced-based policies and practices within local the criminal justice system
- National Network of Criminal Justice Coordinating Councils
