Facilities and Fleet Management Essential Services Include:

- We managed over \$46 million in capital construction over the past 5 years
- We manage 2.6 million sq./ft of building space plus multiple public parks and green spaces
- We manage 3800 vehicles and pieces of equipment, from mowers to dump trucks
- We are an integral part of the Metro Snow Team
- We operate our Facilities at a cost of \$6.51/sq. ft. versus the industry standard of \$8.07 /sq. ft.
- We completed over 8500 work orders in 2019

Employees served as Branch Managers for Safety and Infrastructure as part of Incident Management Team



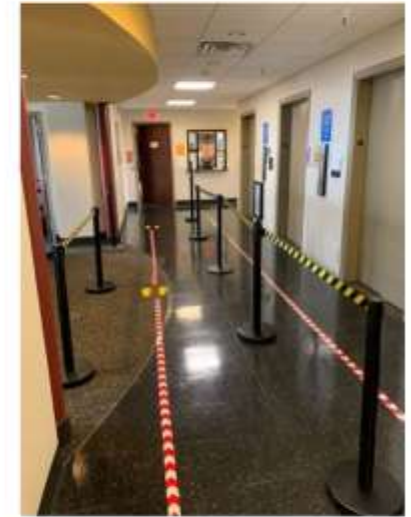

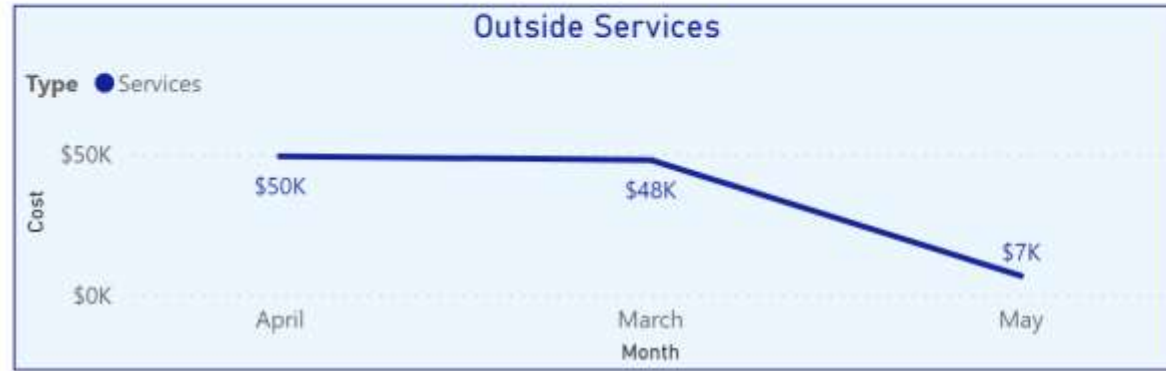

Disposition of LMPD HQ and Fiscal Court Building

In January 2019, Facilities Management submitted a plan for LMPD HQ and the Fiscal Court Building. The report was the culmination of months of work with key stake holders, including Metro Council, and representatives from all occupying agencies. With the passage of the FY 2020 budget, work began on the implementation of this plan. Leased space is being utilized as part of a short-term solution while funding is identified and allocated for the implementation of the complete plan. Space has been identified and plans are being finalized to relocate all employees from the aged facilities.
