**IMPORTANT POINTS: 2020** 

We are still doing greater than 6,000 cases per year with a staff of 12 rotating deputies and 2 deputies doing cremations/ indigent program/ open records requests/ screening and filing/ answering phones

Indigent program has to date

Cremations 12 Burials 32

We have less than 26 places left in our cemetery. Nowhere to go

Types and number of cases to date: on power point handout

Our major cost: contract services (2)

Indigent program average \$100,000.

Body transport average\$250,000. They are asking a \$5.00 increase on the body bags because their cost has increased by that amount.

## **COVID19** costs

The COVID pandemic has cost us over \$5,000.00 in the last 3 months for extra supplies since we are first responders to include; thermometers, body bags, PPE, N95 masks, face shields, hand wash, shoe covers and hand sanitizer etc.

## The Coroner's Office needs:

Secretary position of about \$30,160.00 to help out with phone calls, indigent program, filing and open records requests
Request the annual % raise, if given
Keep the same number of deputies that we have now
Increase postal mail to \$800.00 for certified mailing
Contract for body removal to increase \$5.00 per bag
Coroner's car is 15 yrs. old and has not been replaced but need 4-wheel
SUV that is big enough for dog crates and towing a trailer
