Laboratory volume ~90% of a typical year PLUS over 10,000 COVID-19 tests

The Lead Program was accepted to the National Academy for Public Health Program

WIC participation increased from ~11,000 in 2019 to ~14,000 today

TB Clinic served more patients

Specialty (STD) Clinic saw the same number of patients

Academic Health Department doubled student participation

- Was selected for the American Public Health Association's Thought Leaders Film Series
- Convened a Community Advisory Board for the 2021 HER
- Produced 2 Health Impact Assessments
- Worked with Corrections to implement a Narcan education and distribution program
- Worked with Council on two tobacco ordinances & PPL
- Completed Vital Statistics Report

COVID-19 Response

- Federal Interagency Team called LMPHW a "model of best practice"
- State Public Health Commissioner Steven Stack called LMPHW his "crown jewel"
- LouVax was recently featured in both the New York Times and the Wall Street Journal

- 11,250 covid business investigations
- 10,860 durable goods/essential needs provided
- Provided isolation housing to 276 individuals
- 71,999 covid case investigations
- Trained over 500 people to do case investigations and contact tracing
- 480,404 calls to residents about case investigations and contact tracing
- Teams to support schools, Long Term Care Facilities and congregate living facilities
- Support for NTI hubs
