SIGNATURE PROGRAMS

- **Spectrum Housing Assist** Partnership with nonprofit organizations that engages volunteers to provide critical home repairs. In 2020, we met our commitment of making 50,000 home safer.
- **Spectrum Digital Education** Grant program supporting nonprofit organizations that educate underrepresented communities on the benefits of broadband. Since its 2017 launch, we have awarded \$2.5 million in cash.
- **Spectrum Scholars** a two-year scholarship program for underrepresented college students with financial need.
- **Spectrum Community Investment Loan Fund** a \$20 million commitment to support economic growth in underserved communities, including \$10 million targeted specifically for minority owned businesses through direct investments in community development financial institutions (CDFIs), grants, and in-kind support.
