Who is ETA?

- A local 501(c)(3) non-profit organization
- 100% volunteer managed and operated
- Mission: to protect & expand equine trails that enrich the health of people, horses, land & the economy of Louisville and surrounding counties
- Adoption Partner with Olmsted Parks Conservancy at Iroquois Park

What Does ETA Do?

- Provides community support and education
- Conducts youth education and programs
- Promotes horses and their rich history in Kentucky beyond the race industry
- Hosts equestrian events & fund raisers
- Works with LPR and land managers to maintain and sustain trails and equestrian facilities

2021 Iroquois Park Projects

<u>Projects</u>	<u>Cost Estimates</u>
1. Replace cable fence w/board fence between main trail and golf course (safety issue)	\$ 3,465
2. Replace damaged gates & boards on arena & round pen, mounting block (materials only)	\$ 1,450
3. Excavate & replace drainage system in round pen (materials only)	\$ 150
4. Paint arena, round pen & stand (mat. only)	\$ 1,056
5. Repair posts & trough at wash rack (mat.)	\$ 100
6. Clean, repair & paint barn restrooms (mat.)	\$ 300
7. Equipment & labor for items 2, 3, 5, & 6; repair pot holes in access road and general trail head clean up & repair	<u>\$ 9,000</u>
	\$15,521 Total

Funding Status Laydown

- Total materials & labor costs \$15,521
- ETA resourced (\$12,615)
- **Funding Shortfall \$ 2,906**

Proposed 2022 ETA Projects

- Work with LPR on repairs to stable at IP
- Work with LPR and OPC to expand equestrian trail miles at IP
