




### Big Challenge 1: The K-Shaped Recovery





Black workers in Louisville earn less than their white counterparts at *every* step of the education ladder




Black workers in Louisville also earn less than their white counterparts in *every* industry, and are over-represented in some lower-paying industries while being under-represented in some high paying industries


## Big Challenge 4: The Work From Home Revolution

If all downtown employers shifted just 10% of employees to permanent Work From Home, we would lose this much leased office space >




## Big Challenge 5: Revitalizing Small Businesses


Small business revenue was hit very hard by the COVID pandemic and is a long way from recovery




Some sectors, such as Leisure & Hospitality, were hit especially hard
