



   Yes, Mexican, Mexican Am., Chicano
   Yes, Puerto Rican
   Yes, Cuban
   Yes, another Hispanic, Latino, or Spanish origin − Print, for example, Salvadoran, Dominican, Colombian, Guatemalan, Spaniard, Ecuadorian, etc.
- Due to changes in the wording of the race and ethnicity questions, comparisons to the 2010 Census should be made cautiously
- Important points are that individuals can choose more than one racial group and that Hispanic or Latino ethnicity is considered separately from race






#### Black Population Change, 2010-2020




# Black Population 2020




### Hispanic Population Change, 2010-2020




#### Hispanic/Latino Population 2020




# Asian Population Change, 2010-2020






# Change in Child Population, 2010-2020




#### Vacancy Rates 2020




#### Population in Group Quarters 2020




#### Population per Square Mile 2020
