	Accessible sidewalks are provided throughout the development as well as parking and vehicular circulation. Further, the developer is building a 10' wide shared use path at the frontage as part of the planned Louisville Loop route.

	More than the minimum open space is being provided, and adequate recreational open space is as well in the form of multi-purpose fields and playground.

	Stormwater is being collected and conveyed to a detention basin.

	This development is located within close proximity to downtown Fairdale. New and improved sidewalks promote walkability for residents.
6.	Is the proposal in conformance with the Comprehensive Plan and Land Development Code?
	The project promotes infill developmene near city centers and is providing affordable housing.
