Mr. Burton has provided a safe environment for neighborhood adults to bond and mingle for the past 46 years. The establishment is often referred to as Cheers in the hood, where everyone knows each other and has bonded as family. Mr. Burton, who is 81, was once asked about hanging up his spot, he responded "where would my friends go, how would they continue to see each other." This is one spot that continues to put smiles on faces and joy in others hearts.

Ann Wagner - Mrs. Wagner has been a prominent figure in the Shawnee Neighborhood for at least 50 years. She has been the recipient of many awards and acknowledgements from mayors, governors, President Obama, NAACP, and others. She has worked with past aldermen such as Paul Bather, always around to lend a helping hand. It's time to honor her with an honorary street naming.

Greg Allen - Mr. Allen is retiring from the United States Postal Services after 40+ years. Mr. Allen has been a faithful and diligent mailman, often seen delivering mail in the dark up to 10:00 at night! I asked him why would he work so late when he didn't have to, his response was, "somebody has to get the mail out to the residents."
