Jeff,

We would like to add some additional lighting to the district and get this entered into new business before the year is up. The last new business deadline is November 28th, so I would need all of the pricing and paperwork back by November 22nd due to the Thanksgiving holiday. *Only caveat to this list is the lighting around Algonquin and 22nd, I believe we already agreed on lighting this area, but there have been several accidents at this intersection and it is completely dark at night. There is currently a car hood in front of 2100 Algonquin and SWMS has had to replace the trash receptacle there a couple of times over the last 6 months, due to accidents.

1. On Cane Run Road at Lindell. Intersection is dark as you approach Lindell.

- 2. 22nd St at the alley that runs between Dixdale and Algonquin on the west side.

 The alleyway is dark on the west side until midway down. This dark area gives cover to unlawful activity (dumping, drug use, accessibility to rear yards and occupied dwellings).
 - 3. On McCloskey, south of Algonquin before Dixdale.

 This area is dark and dumping is weekly in that area.
 - 4. 1800 Block of Oregon, northside of street .2 pedestrians were not visible walking (they had on dark clothing).
 - 5. Millers Lane between Old Millers and Cane Run Rd North side Industrial area that has no business lights on after dark
 - 6. On Cane Run South of Bells
 - 7. 2100 Block of Allston
 - 8. 2300 Ratcliffe
 - 9. 1800 Ratcliffe
 - 10. 1700 Harold
 - 11. 1800 Millers
 (After the McDonalds lot down to Plantation)
 - *The light at 22nd and Algonquin is blinking every 2 seconds.
 - 12. Nichols Meadow Circle at March Blvd on the West side.




