Subject: Americana requests for the area around Kenwood Way

I've directed the sign shop to install Truck prohibition signs at the Southside & W Kenwood intersection and the S 1st & Woodlawn Ave intersection to deter trucks from using the area for parking, sorry I don't have an installation date set yet.

Attached are a few options that may help deter the truck parking.

All of the roads within Douglas Park are private so we couldn't require a vehicular connection to E Kenwood Way but it is something we would consider if the property owners/managers wanted to apply for a permit to complete the connection. This would require some road construction though which would be the responsibility of the permittee.

Barricading the end of the road to prevent truck access, with or without the formal road closure, could be an option as long as the church does not need to use that area for access to their property.

We estimate the cost to pave the shoulder along W Kenwood to accommodate parking would be about \$30,000. This section of road was paved in 2017 so it will be a while until it's up again for paving.

Jeff & Mike,

Thanks again for meeting us yesterday to discuss parking solutions for Americana Community Center and the Southside Neighborhood. Below are the discussion items and action steps I collected. Please feel free to make corrections or additions.

Points of understanding:

- ✓ Jeff clarified that the property running alongside Kenwood Way is right-of -way. No one is permitted to park there unless it is concreted or covered with asphalt. Pulling out onto the roadway could drag gravel on to the street.
- ✓ PARC does their best to equitably enforce i.e. they will cite every vehicle they see in the right of way. Per Gloria the semis are being ticketed but disregard enforcement.

Action items:

- ✓ Mike will research the history of citations.
- ✓ Short term No Truck parking signs could be added.
- ✓ Option #1- Americana could request a permit to pave the area.
- ✓ Option #2- The street could possibly be widened if aligned with the paving schedule.

Additional:

- ✓ Consider right of way closure at Kenwood Ct or opening the roadway.
- ✓ Jeff will research the closure of Kenwood Way and pedestrian connections.
- ✓ Jeff will research street lighting options.
- ✓ Emilie will research mowing agreement along right of way.
