The Louisville Metro Department of Public Health and Wellness (LMPHW) operates a variety of clinical services requiring oversight and direction by a duly qualified and licensed medical practitioner. Norton Healthcare through its Division of Pediatric Infectious Diseases will supply LMPHW with a qualified physician to support three key objectives: 1) serve as a medical advisor for specified divisions in LMPHW that require physician direction, including but not limited to reviewing standing orders, policies and protocols, participating in the treatment of patients, and consulting with staff to ensure accurate diagnosis and treatment has been prescribed; 2) serve as a medical advisor assisting LMPHW's senior leadership team with the strategic planning and development of clinical activites, special projects, and external partnerships with the medical community; and 3) serve as a medical expert participating in LMPHW's responses to the media and other related public education activities. The total compensation package for the healthcare provider is \$269,000.00, paid by Norton Healthcare. Louisville Metro Government through LMPHW, will contribute up to \$60,000 to Norton for 15% of the provider's time -\$40,350.00 for salary, \$11,298.00, fringe and \$8,352.00 for additional expenses related to the work (i.e. continuing education, indirect).

JUSTIFICATION FOR NON-COMPETITIVE GOOD/SERVICE (Attach additional documentation if necessary)

LMPHW's Associate Medical Director role has been vacant for 8 months. Even with promotion of the position with community partners, we have had 0 applicants in this time. Given the inability to hire directly for the role, and the immediate need for the services, LMPHW needs to develop a contract with a local physician's group who can provide a physician to fill these services.

Norton Healthcare's medical practitioners possess the requisite experience and qualifications to provide the unique nature of the services desired by LMPHW. Norton Healthcare is the only organization with the flexible staff capacity and interest in engaging in this public-private partnership.

AUTHORIZATIONS: Per KRS 45A.380, I have determined that competition is not feasible for the above described good / service and there is a single source within a reasonable geographical area of the good / service to be procured; or the resulting contract is for the services of a licensed professional, technician, artist, or other non-licensed professional service.
