#### **TECHNICAL REVIEW**

- The request does not conform to LDC Section 6.3.5.K (Continuation of Street names). It states the following: Streets continuing through an intersection shall keep the same name. For commercial, multifamily, or townhouse developments that have an entrance or access through a publicly maintained culde-sac, a separate street name will be required for the entrance or access road in the event that it serves or is intended to serve two or more address numbers. Street names shall not be changed due to a change in direction of the street, nor shall a new prefix be used for those streets that meet the criteria for using a directional indicator in the street name.
- MetroSafe is concerned about the request as it would violate the Land Development Code regulation regarding the continuation of street names by not continuing the street name, Notting Hill Boulevard, west of Standwick Drive.
- The Eastwood Fire Department has no concerns with the request.
- If no such request is received, and affected governmental units having geographical jurisdiction agree to the proposed name change, the public hearing maybe waived.


