KNOCK-OUT ROSES AND PINKY WINKY TREE/SHRUB HEDGES

_	10	Canopy Trees - 1	1/2"-2"
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- 4 Crape Myrtles
- 10 Vitex
- 36 Pinky Winky Hydrangeas
- 64 Knock Out Roses #3 gallon
- 45 cu yds Compost
- 55 cu yds Hardwood Mulch
- Pre and Post-emergence & Landscape Fertilizer
- Labor & Equipment for Landscaping

SUNFLOWERS & POPPIES

- Spray with roundup in April, wait 3 weeks
- Rototill the ground (District 14 to arrange)
- Mid to late May, broadcast sunflower seed
- Fertilizer application after germination
- Mow sunflowers down in mid-September
- Wait one week spray with roundup
- Wait about 2 weeks and rototill ground (District 14 to arrange)
- Sow poppies in late September

MAINTENANCE

Maintenance commitment for a three year period: starting FY14/FY15 going through FY16/FY17. Total cost of maintenance is \$3,000 a year (billed at the start of each Fiscal Year).

Initial cost to install Tree/Shrub Hedges	\$9,240
One time cost to assist with wildflowers	\$1,534
One time cost for 2 New Signs	\$ 600

^{*}Pinky Winky Hydrangea blooms from late spring into end of summer and Knock-out Roses will bloom throughout the growing season. Both are perennials and will come back every year with maintenance. There will not be continued maintenance with the wildflowers from Brightside (results not guaranteed).
