

Members shall reside in Jefferson County and no more than one member shall reside within any council district. The members so appointed shall include persons who are representative of the several social, economic, cultural, ethnic, and racial groups that
comprise the population of Metro Louisville.

Members shall serve without compensation, but subject to the approval of he Mayor and within the limits imposed by the budget, they shall be allowed the necessary expenses attendant upon their duties.
