American Metal Supply is a Steel and Metals Distributor and Manufacturer located at 1250 Old Fern Valley Rd, Louisville Kentucky. They are reviewing the opportunity of acquiring adjacent land to our current facility to build an expansion for our business. The initial expansion would be 15,000 sq. feet of craned space to expand their stocking and manufacturing capabilities and further develop their business in the states of Tennessee and Indiana. American Metal Supply is reviewing the opportunity to open up satellite facilities in these states, but is also considering this expansion as a potential supplemental option to those choices.
