I have spoken with Mr. Bryan Slade with EcoTech and he has explained that they will be unable to pick up any of the trash receptacles along Dixie for D-25 & D-14. Liz Kennedy with Councilman Blackwell's office explained she has been working with TARC to address locations along the Greenbelt Highway. Could you please pass along an example of your Memorandum of Agreement for specific businesses to agree to empty the Trash at neighboring TARC stops?

I am currently reviewing the following locations along D-25's Dixie Highway Locations:

- 2) Trash Can along Meijer
- 3) Trash Can along Tumbleweed at the Southwest Regional Library location
