Small urban street trees only. No other botanical, topographical or environmental assets. All esisting landscape is being preserved. This plan provides for a small increase in sodded areas on this site. This site lies within the Russell National Register Historic District. No asset in this district is compromised by this adaptive reuse of this building.

Is safe and efficient vehicular and pedestrian transportation provided both within the development and the community?

Yes. Vehicular and pedestrian traffic in the community remains unchanged. The on site vehicular traffic patterns are improved with the deletion of an old drive through lane along the building edge.

i. Is sufficient open space (scenic and recreational) to meet the needs of the proposed development being provided?

Yes. The existing condition as it relates to this question remains unchanged.

Yes. The existing storm water management on the site remains unchanged. The gross impervious area of the site is decreased marginally with the deletion of the drive through lane along the side of the building. This is replaced in part with landscape.

i. Is the overall site design (location of buildings, parking lots, screening, landscaping) and land use or uses compatible with the existing and projected future development of the area?

Yes. The site design remains largely unchanged. Two fenced areas are added to the site. These are composed of brick fence post and a decorative all aluminum vertical square tube picket fencing. The fence is finished in a mat black color.
