

The cost for a light at this location would be \$904.80 for 5 years.

I'll speak with LG&E to provide an estimate of the cost for 5 years, which normally takes about two weeks for the inspection to come back to me. I'll advise you of the cost associated and wait for money to be appropriated if Councilmen Ackerson decides to fund it. Once money has been appropriated, Director Burns signs the copy of the contracts and I notify LG&E to install the light. Installation typically takes 2-4 weeks provided no more crazy weather.
