

- Provides training for the community in cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR), use of Automatic External Defibrillators (AED), First Aid, Basic Life Support skills and advanced classes for medical professionals
- Hands-Only CPR new in 2015 HANDDS Program




 3,000+ classes taught & 15,000+ individuals certified in 2014








HANDDS Program – Zip Codes with Low By-Stander CPR







Public Services Communications (MetroCall 311)

- In its 25th year, MetroCall answered its 5 millionth call on March 10, 2015 at 2:20 PM!
- 216,117 contacts from citizens and visitors in 2014
 - Phone
 - Email
 - Web-Entry and Mobile App
 - Live chat
 - Twitter
- MetroCall also puts on "911 for Kids" and preparedness events in the community
 - More than 80 of these events were held in 2014





Public Safety Communications (MetroSafe)

- Personnel include:
 - 911 Call Takers and Dispatchers
 - Tech Systems Support
 - Radio System Support
 - Administrative
- Received 1.4 million calls in the 911 Communications Center in 2014
 - 82% wireless
 - 11% wired
 - 7% Voice over Internet Protocol (VoIP)
- Dispatched 725,542 calls for service in 2014
- Major projects underway:
 - Computer-Aided Dispatch upgrade
 - Unified Protocol

- 16 different tower sites and 19 generators
- Capital Appropriations Project #7
 Multi-Agency Voice Radio System (MVRS) Upgrade
 - Increases interoperability
 - Ability to take advantage of advancements in technology
 - Enables digital paging
 - Greatly reduces security risks







Louisville Emergency Notification System (LENS)


Community notification system that provides critical communication to citizens before, during and after natural or man-made disasters



 National Crime Information Center (NCIC) – Zero errors on an audit by Kentucky State Police









- Citizen survey conducted by MetroCall 311 to gain "Voice of the Customer" data
 - Vacant and Abandoned Properties
 - Completed over 350 surveys with citizens affected by Vacant and Abandoned Properties
 - Partnered with Develop Louisville –
 Vacant and Public Property Administration Division









- Little Hands and Little Feet Gun Safety and Violence Prevention Program
 - Encourages students to practice non-violent means of conflict resolution
 - 60 youngsters graduated on May 7, 2015












 Louisville Metro EMS received the American Heart Association "Mission: Lifeline" EMS Silver

Performance Achievement Award

- One of 447 agencies nationally and one of 15 other EMS agencies in Kentucky
- Criteria is based on meeting achievement measures annually above 75% for all criteria





- Atrus Automatic External Defibrillator (AED) Link
 Program launched in January 2015
 - Atrus AED Link™ system is an innovative program that helps the 911
 Communication Center increase the benefits of publicly placed automated external defibrillators (AEDs) deployed in the community.

 Notifies persons associated with the AED of the location of the cardiac event.
