#### Major Harper:

As discussed CM Yates wishes to provide Overtime funding through his Neighborhood Development Fund dollars to allow for increased police patrol in District 25. Our Specific issues are:

- 1) Speeding in our neighborhoods and arterial roads
- 2) Illegal use of ATV's & other recreational vehicles in the Sand Pit off of the Woodridge Lake Subdivision on Jefferson Memorial Park Grounds. The entrance being used by the ATV owners is also a hot spot for Heroin/drug sales/usage as well as a dumping ground.
- 3) These funds can also be utilized to help hold drug drop offs at the Southwest Government Center to help fight the illegal use of prescription drugs and get expired drugs easily off the streets.
- 4) Councilman Yates also hopes in the near future to discuss the Waverly Park entrance that is not being locked up consistently by Parks due to budget cuts. CM Yates understands that LMPD was asked in years past to close the entrance to Waverly after dark. CM Yates would like to ensure Waverly does get locked up regularly as during the summer the increased amount of late night Waverly park visitors increases and neighbors are reporting finding syringes, hearing gun shots and cleaning up alcohol bottles throughout the week and weekend.

Councilman Yates wishes to provide \$3,000 to combat these issues. Please alert our office if you will accept the overtime funding.
