There are 3 trees at this location that are a concern.

The first two are the dead elms. They definitely need to be removed. The third is an ash tree that is showing crown dieback---likely EAB infestation. Based on the Bob Ray contract here are the costs that you are looking at:

1	Elm	21"	\$768.00
2	Elm	34"	\$1248.00
3	Ash	21"	\$768.00

The ash tree is only showing around 10% dieback. If CM Hollander wants to wait on removal, I can reevaluate it next year. Let me know.
