ABSTRACT

It has been said that Catherine Spalding created the first spectrum of health, education and social services in the bustling mid 1830s of Louisville. It is in this spirit that we propose the Mother Catherine Spalding Statue be erected on public land in front of the Cathedral of the Assumption property at 433 S. Fifth Street.

A woman of energy and compassion, Mother Catherine sought out abandoned, immigrant children as they arrived at the Louisville wharf and built an orphanage to shelter them. At first, the children were sheltered in a small house behind the church where she lived. Later, Catherine reached out to the women of Louisville and together they raised money to build a house for the care and shelter of additional orphans. Within three years, riverboats and urban disease caused an increase in the number of parentless children, which required the purchase of even larger quarters. It was named the St. Vincent Orphanage and lasted well beyond Catherine Spalding's lifetime.

Schools throughout Kentucky established by Mother Catherine included: Nazareth Academy (1814), St. Vincent's Academy (1820), St. Catherine's Academy/Lexington (1823), Presentation Academy (1831), St. Vincent's Orphan Asylum (1832), St. Joseph's Hospital (1836), and St. Francis' School at Owensboro (1850). Even Spalding University in Louisville was named in her honor.

We can credit this exceptional leader for the founding of schools and hospitals at a time when education for girls, private health care and organized social services didn't exist on the Kentucky frontier. She died on March 20, 1858, but she left behind a legacy that continues today, not just in the state of Kentucky, but extending throughout our nation and on international mission work through the Sisters of Charity. Many Kentuckians trace their family histories to the educational institutions or hospitals she founded

Importantly, the installation of the Mother Catherine Spalding statue would be history-making in and of itself, as the first portrayal of a woman on public land the Louisville. We feel it is only fitting that this distinction be given to a woman who not only impacted our community, but the region and the world with her service to others.

The Mother Catherine Spalding Statue Planning Committee oversaw a very rigorous selection and review process that included proposed models, specific criteria, scoring and interviews. Out of four finalists the committee chose Raymond Graf because of his talent and ability to capture the essence and likeness of Mother Catherine Spalding.

Artist Conceptual Scope

With facts and ideas taken from the book, Pioneer Spirit – Catherine Spalding, Sister of Charity of Nazareth (written by Mary Ellen Doyle, SCN), the artist put together a scenario of Mother Catharine delivering two orphans from the waterfront to the orphanage. Graf has consulted with both the planning committee as well as with SCN leadership to ensure a respectful likeness of Mother Catherine is captured correctly.

The statue will be placed on the Cathedral Plaza in front of the present Parish Office Building (formally the Cathedral School). The statue's placement is such that Mother Catherine, accompanied by two small orphans (one boy and one girl), has just returned to the Cathedral from the banks of the river (where she rescued the two orphans). The statue does not block or impede foot traffic and will blend into the current flow.

Artist Qualifications

Raymond Graf currently lives in Louisville and is one of Kentucky's best bronze sculptors. With over 20 life size bronze statues in the area, his resume is a literal who's who of significant historical and community persons throughout Kentucky.

Construction Methods, Materials and Installation Plans

After modeling the project in clay, rubber molds will be made to then use the lost wax process to cast the sculpture in bronze at the Bright Foundry located at 1621 East Washington Street in Louisville.

Artist, Raymond Graf, will make the statue of silicon bronze. Stainless steel rods will be welded to the interior of the statue to anchor it into the reinforced concrete below the sidewalk pavers.

Koetter Construction, Inc. will pour a support of reinforced concrete replacing the current paver stones on top. The artist will use a diamond core drill to dill holes through the sidewalk paver stones into the reinforced concrete below. The reinforced concrete will be a minimum of 4' x 4' square by 2' deep. The statue will then be epoxied into the reinforced concrete footer using the large stainless steel rods that are welded in to the interior of the statue as the support and anchoring method

Supporting Architecture

The reinforced concrete footer will be approx. 4' x 4' and 2' deep with the existing brick pavers replaced on top.

Maintenance Plan

Per the artist instructions, the statue will only require an annual waxing. The Cathedral of the Assumption maintenance staff will be responsible for the annual maintenance of the statue, with the oversight of the MCS Committee. The maintenance of the statue will be incorporated into the annual Maintenance budget of the Cathedral of the Assumption.

Lighting

No lighting plan is proposed. The statue will be lit by an existing streetlight on Fifth Street.

Community Outreach Program Plan

The official public unveiling and dedication of the Mother Catherine Spalding Statue will be Sunday, July 26, 2015 at 1:30 p.m. (following the 12 Noon Mass). This event will be open to the public and will involve community leaders and special interest groups whose history is related to Mother Catherine Spalding. A public relations plan will be formed and put into action to attract local and state media representatives.

In addition, plans are being formed for both temporary and permanent historical displays featuring artifacts related to Mother Catherine Spalding and the Sisters of Charity of Nazareth. These displays will be part of the Archdiocese of Louisville History Center located directly across from the Cathedral of the Assumption. Tri-fold pamphlet(s) will further educate visitors and schools on the work of Mother Catherine Spalding, SCN.






