Iroquois Park North Overlook

A timeline has been established for a project that will improve the landscape and access to the North Overlook in Iroquois Park by Spring 2016.

Louisville Metro Parks & Recreation and the Olmsted Parks Conservancy met with officials from EZ Construction, Inc. in late July and determined that construction will begin the week of August 10. According to EZ Construction, the general contractor for the project, work is expected to be completed within six months of the start date.

Vehicular traffic from Sullivan Grove to the current North Overlook will be prohibited. The Corbly Trail, which leads to the North Overlook, will also be closed. Those wishing to access the overlook during the construction period must do so only via the roadway by foot or bicycle from the Sullivan Grove Trailhead/parking area. The gate to the hill will be open and closed as normal this summer and fall, and will be closed, as it typically is, during the winter months. Due to construction, access to the actual Overlook itself will also be prohibited.

The \$1 million project's cost is being funded by the Olmsted Parks Conservancy and Louisville Metro Parks & Recreation. It will include rustic stone sitting tiers with views of downtown Louisville and the Indiana Knobs, enhanced landscaping, improved access to trailheads and wheelchair-accessible paths to the North Overlook.
