Friends, looks like a mistake was made concerning the EAF funding of our Adult Day Center. As you will recall, FCHUM originally requested \$15,000. The original recommendation in the mayor's budget was for just \$5,000. I contacted your offices with concern, and requested that you try to get the additional \$10,000 restored to bring it back to our request of \$15,000. We received word from your office that you were successful with that task, and that the additional funds actually came from general budget rather than from your offices. Yesterday we received an email indicating that our EAF funding for the Adult Day Center was \$10,000. I think some confusion may have occurred in Council discussions, or in transfer of information to Office of Finances. I think your intent was to add \$10,000 in order to restore our request to the full \$15,000, but someone along the way misinterpreted that \$10,000 to be the total request. I have been informed that this should be a relatively easy matter to be corrected through proper channels. I will leave that in your capable hands. Thank you.
