Can you give a breakdown of each? The turf, national organization and irrigation? Thanks for your quick responses. I can start the paperwork as soon as CM Yates approves.



Hey David I hope all is going well. We had spoken awhile back about a FootGolf facility in your district. You had mentioned you might be willing to help me with some of our cost. Well we are ready to pull trigger on this — we have been working with in house staff to construct.
