The YMCA Safe Place provides shelter as an alternative to detention for youth in cases where the offense is non-violent or minor in nature, such as shoplifting, being reported as a runaway or status offenses (such as truancy). This serves the purpose of keeping the limited space available at the Youth Detention Center open for greater needs and providing a place for parents to locate youth that have been removed from unsafe or disruptive situations by LMPD. LMPD takes the youth directly to the YMCA Save Place and they are not processed in the Youth Detention Center.

The YMCA is a partnering agency in Metro's Field Release Program working through schools and LMPD. Any change to the existing operation workflow resulting from a bid process would significantly impact the efficiency of the department, limited available space at the center and processes for LMPD as they relate to the youth qualified to enter the YMCA Safe Place.
