Before I say anything let me say I don't know these roads and which comes first... But I want to make certain what we are saying.

If we were to pave from Taylorsville Rd to the first intersection with Rehl Road it would be \$175,000 If we were to pave from Taylorsville Rd to Poplar Lane it would be \$265,000

Correct? And if so, we have decided to shorten the span to just the \$175,000. On our "wish list" we had paving from Taylorsville Rd to Poplar Lane estimated at \$60,000 and no one knows where that number came from (and it does not matter at this point). On the PAV request I still had the wording from Taylorsville Rd to Poplar Lane and funded \$89,000. District 20 has committed to using CIF for an additional \$40,000. I have identified another \$5,000 from old Republican CIF pool, but that leaves us short by \$40,714. I have not finished evaluating "old" projects to see if there are remaining funds, but before I did much more on this I wanted to make certain I had it "right". If so, are there any other options?
