Proposal for Professional Services

Dear Mr. Baker:

Gresham, Smith and Partners is pleased to have the opportunity to present this proposal to you (the Client) for professional planning services for landscape associated with the above referenced project, and more specifically described as follows:

Scope of Work

The GS&P Scope of Work will consist of:

- Planned Development District Expanded Inventory/Analysis: GSP will conduct a
 detailed inventory and analysis of the properties within the proposed Town Center
 Form District (TCFD) as identified in the Highview Neighborhood Plan. Inventory
 and analysis will consist of:
 - Analysis of existing development pattern including lot configurations, building scale/massing, and existing zoning and land uses
 - Analysis of existing transportation network including sidewalk locations, widths and condition; pedestrian crossings and intersection design, and number and spacing of curb cuts

The first additional meeting will be to present the final plan recommendations. The second additional meeting will be to conduct a design charrette to establish the foundation for the Planned Development Districts form and character.

- 4. <u>Public Meetings:</u> GS&P will attend 2 additional public meetings beyond the number of public meetings established in the original Neighborhood Plan scope. The first additional meeting will be to present the final plan recommendations. The second additional meeting will be to review the Planned Development District framework developed from the charrette and revise the framework based on feedback received.
- 5. <u>Deliverables:</u> GS&P will deliver the Highview Planned Development District standards through a written report with accompanying graphics. The report will be produced in a format acceptable to Louisville Forward staff consistent with the Land Development Code, suitable for adoption and include specific recommendations for a PDD area-wide rezoning.

Compensation
