WHEREAS, the Metro Government wishes to enter into this agreement through

the Metro Parks Department.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT (THE COUNCIL) AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I: The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with the Commonwealth of Kentucky Transportation Cabinet to accept funding of \$86,400 for the design phase of a multi-use path along Iroquois Parks' Rundill Road. Design will reduce lanes to 10 feet for vehicular traffic and designate 10-foot lanes for bike/pedestrian traffic and add 10 rest stations along Rundill Road.

SECTION II: This Resolution shall take effect upon its passage and approval.
