FOR COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE MERGER OF ELDERSERVE AND GUARDIACARE. (AS AMENDED)

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT (THE COUNCIL) AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I: The sum of \$8,250 \$10,250 \$12,000 is hereby appropriated from

Neighborhood Development Funds, in the following manner: \$2,000 from District

13; \$1,000 each from Districts 25, 12, 8, 24, 15; \$750 from District 6; \$500 each

from Districts <u>14, 22, 17, 21,</u> 6, 9, 25; \$250 each from Districts <u>3, 7, 20, 5,</u> 10, 2,

16; through the Office of Management and Budget, to ElderServe, Inc. for costs

associated with the merger of ElderServe and GuardiaCare.

SECTION II: The Council has determined the funds requested in this Ordinance will be expended for a public purpose.

SECTION III: This grant is subject to the Council's Policies and Procedures as adopted and effective at the date of passage of this Ordinance.

SECTION IV: This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and approval.


