


 Close two segments of an alley in a block bound by 17th and 18th Streets to the East and West, and Cedar Street and Muhammad Ali Boulevard to the North and South




Case Summary / Background

- First segment is a 20' wide alley running from 17th to 18th Street
- Second segment is a 10' wide alley beginning at the North line of the East/West alley and terminating at the South line of Cedar Street
- Will be consolidated with the abutting property owned by Louisville metro Government/Urban Renewal and Community Development Agency
- The alley proposed for closure is currently improved with parking facilities for the African American Heritage Foundation









PC Recommendation

- Public Hearing was held on 8/4/2016
 - No one spoke in opposition.
- The Commission made sufficient findings that the proposal complies with the Comprehensive Plan-Cornerstone 2020
- The Commission recommended approval of the closure by a vote of 7-0 (7 members voted)
