

Foreclosures Initiated	100	90
Metro Demolitions	100	108
Net Payment/Collections from Fines, Abatement Costs, and Liens	\$2.7 million	\$2,694,865



Vacant and Abandoned Properties Landbank Authority

<u>Acquires</u> Vacant Land and Structures by voluntary donations and foreclosures.

<u>Sells</u> vacant land and houses to residents, non-profits, developers, and business owners based on current pricing policy in order to return parcels to productive use.




