



Case Summary / Background

July 22, 2016----ABC Board hearing rescheduled in order, since appellant applied for nonconforming use.

July 19, 2016---Appeal application was submitted.

May, 2016-----Uniform Citation was issued.

May, 2005---- the present owner bought the property at County Commissioner's Sale.



Case Summary Background

January 5, 2004, Letter from Alcoholic Beverage Control allowing the consumption of malt liquor beverages on the premises at the current level. Letter also stated that the right being granted was not establishing nonconforming rights and therefore cannot be transferred to subsequent purchaser of the business or property.

November 24, 2003---Letter from Department of Inspections, Permits & Licenses, Alcoholic Beverage Control Division to South Dixie Liquors- "consumption of beer and/or malt liquor beverages on their premises allowed to continue if they are able to demonstrate to the ABC Administrator that they have been allowing consumption of purchases on their premises since 1978."



Staff Analysis and Conclusions

After the property was purchased in 2005, the owner was under the impression that the beer consumption was "grandfathered".

Since that time consumption has continued and inspections have been made.

Not until this year was the business cited.

The package store usually closes around 11:00 pm.

The store has an older crowd.

Consumption takes place inside the store and outside under a canopy and by the rear door entrance.



Required Actions

- Based upon the file of this case, this staff report, and the evidence and testimony submitted at the public hearing, the Board must determine if nonconforming rights exist for the inside and outside consumption of beer.
- If so, the Board will need to determine the areas.
- If the Citation issued by the Department of Codes and Regulations was proper?
