AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT

This Amendment to Agreement, made and entered into by and between the LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT, acting by and through its LOUISVILLE METRO DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH AND WELLNESS, hereinafter referred to as "METRO GOVERNMENT" or "METRO" and the UNIVERSITY OF LOUISVILLE ("UNIVERSITY"), by and through its SCHOOL OF PUBLIC HEALTH AND INFORMATION SCIENCES ("ULPH"), 485 East Gray Street, Louisville, KY 40202.

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the Metro Government and University executed a contract for the employment of a Director of the Center for Health Equity ("Director") for LMPHW and the Board of Health; and

WHEREAS, the parties wish to amend the Agreement by changing its not-to-exceed amount;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is agreed by and between the parties hereto as follows:

Section I. That Agreement Section II, entitled "Fees and Compensation", Subsection A is hereby amended in its entirety to read as follows:

The Metro Government shall contribute to ULPH one half of the Director's compensation, and shall provide payment to ULPH on a monthly basis after receipt of a detailed invoice from University. The Director's annual compensation shall be **ONE HUNDRED**TWENTY- THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$120,000.00).

ULPH shall generate a University paycheck to Director. ULPH further agrees that

Director shall receive all usual and ordinary faculty benefits including fringe benefits through

University.

In the event that the Metro Government terminates this Agreement, the Metro Government shall not be responsible for any further contribution to ULPH for the ULPH employee and the employee shall no longer hold the Director position. ULPH shall then solely determine the employee's wage and duties.

In the event that ULPH terminates Director, ULPH shall not be responsible for any further compensation of the employee; provided, however, the Metro Government shall then have the opportunity to hire the terminated ULPH employee. The Metro Government shall then solely determine the employee's wage and duties.

In the event a Director terminates his/her employment with ULPH for any reason or if Metro Government is unable to directly hire a Director that has been terminated by ULPH (as outlined above), the parties will work together to identify, recruit and hire a replacement Director that is satisfactory to both parties (provided that no payments shall be due under this Agreement from Metro Government during the period when the Director position is vacant).

In the event that ULPH were to increase their portion of the Director's salary, that will in no way increase the obligation of Metro Government.

The Metro Government shall contribute to ULPH upon receipt of an invoice for same TEN THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED FIFTY DOLLARS (\$10,250.00) toward payment of Director's fringe benefits.

Total annual compensation payable by Louisville Metro under this Agreement shall not exceed SEVENTY THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED FIFTY DOLLARS (\$70,250.00), which amount reflects Louisville Metro's obligation to pay one half of the Director's salary and its contribution toward payments of Director's fringe benefits by ULPH.

Section II. All other terms and conditions as set forth in the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect as if fully set out herein.
