

STATUTORY AUTHORITY	KRS Ch. 344
ORDINANCE AUTHORITY1	LMCO 32.761
POWERS	Act as conciliator in controversies involving intergroup and interracial relations.
REMOVAL	Members are subject to removal by the Mayor at the discretion of the Mayor.

DETAILS VACANCY APPOINTMENT DETAILS QUORUM HOW APPOINTED Mayor with approval of Council **QUALIFICATION OF** Members shall reside in Jefferson County and no more than one member shall reside within any council district.
