Public Works has fielded various complaints in regards to the alley between Cherokee Rd and Everett Ave running from Highland Ave and Grinstead Dr. This alley is comprised of pavers and due to being in a historic district, must be repaired with pavers. Upon our review Public Works estimates that the repair work will be above \$20,000.00.
