We received this notice: There are two upcoming meetings regarding planning/zoning cases in District 17. One involves a binding element amendment to eliminate a portion of Binding Element #3 from case 16DEVPLAN1057 (4610 Chamberlain Lane) which prohibits small freestanding signs on the property. This proposal will be heard by the Development Review Committee on Wednesday, November 30 at the Old Jail Building, 514 W. Liberty Street.
