The decorative cans are \$598.00 each, installed by the contractor. Additional can liners are \$140 each

They are collected on the normal recycling collection day of the week. We have found most materials discarded in them are recyclable.

NDF (funds) through your council district transferred to SWMS allows us to order them. Each can is hand made here in Louisville through a local contractor. Once funds have been transferred, the can is ordered. Installation is usually with 4 to 6 weeks. "SHELBY PARK" lettering can be placed on each decorative can at no additional cost.
