Dear Councilwoman Welch,

The 13th annual Forest Fest is scheduled for May 20, 2017! Attendance at Jefferson Memorial Forest events has grown steadily in number and diversity over the past few years, and we anticipate this year's Forest Fest to be no different.

Each year, we bring award-winning bluegrass and Americana acts to Jefferson Memorial Forest. Last year's headliner included the 17-time International Bluegrass Music Award winner and Greater Louisville resident, fiddler Michael Cleveland. A video taken at the fest of Cleveland and mandolinist Nathan Livers (on the Forest Fest Facebook page) has gone viral, with over 800,00 views! Last year's Forest Fest, with Metro Council's support of \$15,000, saw the best crowd yet, with an estimate of 2500 in attendance. We expanded beyond bluegrass to include other acoustic acts, such as Louisville favorite Ben Sollee, so as to attract even more first-timers to Jefferson Memorial Forest. Even despite the rain, families enjoyed the fantastic music, food, arts and crafts, and nature play.

As you can see from the table below, we anticipate total expenses to carry out this free-to-the public festival of \$31,500. To cover expenses we are requesting \$20,000 from Metro Council. Event revenues (e.g., from parking/vendors/booths as well as sponsorships) will make up the difference.
