

To contract and be contracted with; to sue and be sued; to establish, alter and enforce rules and regulations in furtherance of the purpose of the transit authority's creation; acquire real or personal property, easements, franchises, bus certificates, or other rights by any lowful means necessary to its operation of any exiting mase transit system (incl. through the power of eminant domain); may issue revenus bonds, and general obligation bonds; provide for insurance of its properties, for workers compensation, for public liability or any other risk or hazard arising from its activities; may conduct such studies and surveys, gather such information, and institute such programs and plans as may be reasonable necessary to carry cut the purpose of the transit authority
