Wanda,

Please see my estimates below in red:

- Alley behind Mt. Horeb Baptist Church between 17<sup>th</sup> & 18<sup>th</sup> Street and St. Catherine and Gallagher This is a brick paver alley with significant wheel ruts running the entire length. The alley is located in a non-historical part of town so we can replace with brick or asphalt. If we replaced with brick pavers I estimate it will cost \$115,000.00. To construct the alley with asphalt in line with our standards we would have to remove 12 inches of existing pavers/soil and replace with 8 inches of crushed stone and 4 inches of asphalt at a minimum. I estimate the reconstruction of this alley with asphalt to be \$55,000.00. Please note that \$10,000.00 of this estimate would be for the contractor to preserve any in-tact pavers and deliver to our roads crews for re-use as part of ordinances we must follow.
- Alley between Gallagher and hale Avenue (see photo attached with mattresses dumped) This is an alley which may have had 2 inches of asphalt placed over stone at some point but 80% of the asphalt appears to either be gone or covered with crushed stone. I am estimating that we will need to remove 12 inches of material and replace with 8 inches of crushed stone and 4 inches of asphalt. I estimate to do this work it will cost \$55,000.00.
- Alley between Montana and Creel and 5<sup>th</sup> Street (see photo, alley curves and dead ends at a tree) This alley was previously asphalted but in poor condition similar to the alley between Gallagher and Hale above. To perform a 12 inch removal and replacement with 8 inches of crushed stone and 4 inches of asphalt I estimate that this alley will cost \$42,500.00.

Please note that the estimates provided are worst case scenarios and the work outlined may not be necessary throughout the entire length of each alley but I will not know for sure until the excavation begins. Given the current state of each alley I believe that the work outlined is close to what will be needed.
