SECTION I: The amount of \$9,000 is hereby appropriated from District 17 Neighborhood Development Funds, through the Office of Management and Budget, to the Jefferson County Public Education Foundation, Inc. for the replacement of playground equipment, which will benefit the school and the surrounding community, at Zachary Taylor Elementary School.

SECTION II: The Council has determined the funds requested in this Ordinance will be expended for a public purpose.

SECTION III: This grant is subject to the Council's Policies and Procedures as adopted and effective at the date of passage of this Ordinance.

SECTION IV: This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and approval.
