The attached CIF from Republicans has a few things I hope can be addressed.

- 1. The City Agency is listed as "Library" however the scope of the project clearly falls under the purview of Public Works
- 2. Contact person Matt Frazure is now retired.
- 3. The scope of the project actually is two distinct parts 1) a new traffic signal & ped flashers which would be managed by Pat Johnson of Traffic Engineering; 2) Sidewalks after the traffic signals which falls under the management of Craig Allen.
- 4. The total estimate for the projects are \$100K for signals and \$27K for sidewalks. (hopefully estimates from PWA's traffic engineering and sidewalk construction) however the actual amount designated is \$111,171.58..? It would seem the signals could be done first for \$100K and sidewalks to follow closely.

Since construction in slated to be completed by DEC 2018 – seems there is time to clarify the items above to ensure proper oversight of the these PWA infrastructure components.
