

RESOLUTION NO. 28, SERIES 2017

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER OF ONE (1) PARCEL OF REAL PROPERTY LOCATED AT 4212 ALGONQUIN PARKWAY (1003-0006-0000), BY THE LOUISVILLE AND JEFFERSON COUNTY LANDBANK AUTHORITY, INC.

WHEREAS, according to KRS 65.370, the Louisville and Jefferson County Landbank Authority, Inc., (the “Authority”) may enact resolutions for the purpose of sale or conveyance of real property owned by the Authority; and

WHEREAS, according to KRS 65.370 (d), the Authority shall have the power to manage, maintain, protect, rent, lease, repair, insure, alter, sale, trade, exchange or otherwise dispose of any property on terms and conditions as determined by KRS 65.350 to 65.375 and by the Authority; and

WHEREAS, the real property, which is the subject of this Resolution, has never been dedicated by virtue of use, deed, ordinance or any other manner for a public or governmental purpose.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD MEMBERS OF THE LOUISVILLE AND JEFFERSON COUNTY LANDBANK AUTHORITY, INC.,

SECTION 1. That the Board Members, of the Louisville and Jefferson County Landbank Authority, Inc., hereby authorize the sale of the following described property (the “Property”):

SECTION 2. That the Chairman of the Louisville and Jefferson County Landbank Authority, Inc., or his designee, is hereby authorized and directed to transfer the Property in the manner provided according to KRS 65.370, to The Rushlow Group, LLC (the “Applicant”), for the renovation of a single-family residence, without further action by the Authority.

SECTION 3. That the transfer of the Property is subject to approval of the Nonconforming Rights Application submitted to Planning and Design Services.

SECTION 4. That the Applicant shall maintain the Property in a manner consistent with the Codes and Ordinances of the Louisville/Jefferson County Metro Government (“Louisville Metro”).

SECTION 5. That the Applicant shall obtain all permits required by Louisville Metro and shall complete the renovation of the single-family residence within twelve (12) months of the acquisition of the Property;

SECTION 6. That the Applicant shall return the property back to the Authority should the Applicant fail to meet the requirements of Section 4 and Section 5 above; such requirements being included and recorded as a deed restriction which shall terminate on the date the Authority issues a Deed of Release and Satisfaction.

SECTION 7. That this Resolution shall become effective upon its passage and approval.
